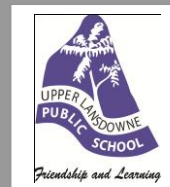

Tuesday 8 March is International Women's Day

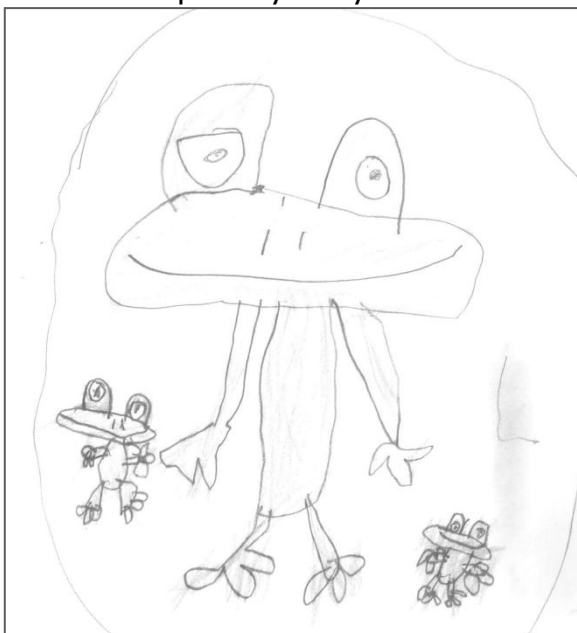
International Women's Day (IWD) is a global event that celebrates the economic, political and social achievements of women past, present and future.
