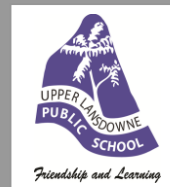



### **Stewart House Donation Drive 2011**



Children in the care of Stewart House attend a specific purpose school onsite for 8 days of their 12-day stay. The NSW Department of Education and Training provides infrastructure and staffing support for this school. All others costs associated with the children's stay are met from charitable donations.
