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
Just a Reminder - Defibrillator

Upper Lansdowne PS has purchased a defibrillator which our local community will be able to use in times of emergency. In emergencies, it takes an ambulance a minimum of 40 minutes to travel to Upper Lansdowne. Administrating CPR for that length of time, would be extremely difficult and emotionally overwhelming. Therefore, having a defibrillator to restore and/or maintain life is vital.

Defibrillators are devices that restore a normal heartbeat by sending an electric pulse or shock to the heart. They are used to prevent or correct an arrhythmia, a heartbeat that is uneven or that is too slow or too fast. Defibrillators can also restore the heart's beating if the heart suddenly stops.

The defibrillator has been placed on the **outside wall** of the office, on the verandah, which allow community members to park in the carpark, "run" into the school and "grab" the defibrillator.

Please remember, if someone is unresponsive and not breathing, it is imperative to call an ambulance on triple zero (000), start CPR and use the defibrillator as soon as possible.
