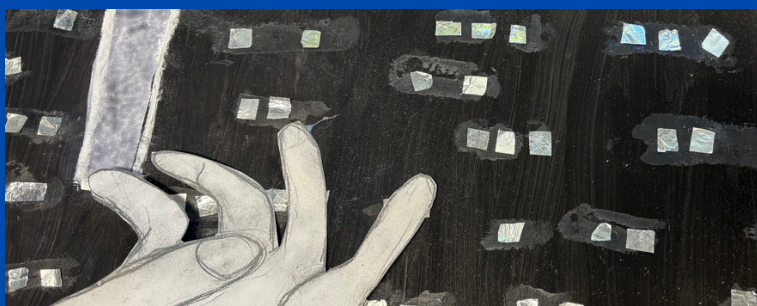
ACMF Song Competition Update

We are lucky to have Tyler, an SLSO from Lansdowne PS coming to translate and teach us the song in sign language this week.

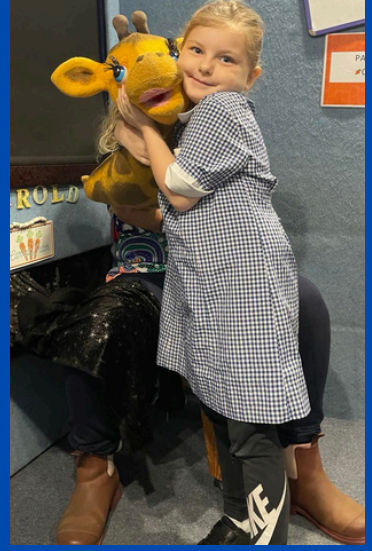
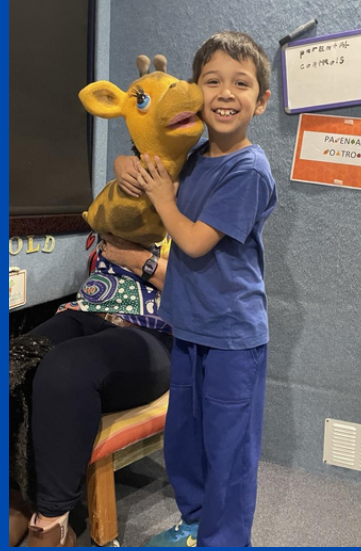
We will be performing the song at the MEC in Term 3, Week 3 as a part of Education Week.
